The Papua New Guinea National Research Institute (PNG NRI) is now inviting aspiring future researchers who enjoy research and solving problems, interested in public policy and are passionate about the future of PNG to apply for the 2021/2022 Research Internship Training Program.

Applicants must have graduated from university no earlier than 2019 with a bachelor degree to become public policy research interns. The Internship will provide graduates an opportunity for further learning about research methods, research paper writing and public policy. It will also provide the graduates the opportunity to conduct research with the support of a mentor at PNG NRI, and the opportunity to work in the field and contribute to real research projects.

PNG NRI is seeking applicants who possess the following skills, experiences and achievements:

- Completed a degree in economics, public policy, political science, land studies and environmental science, or other social sciences disciplines.
- Must have graduated no earlier than 2019.
- GPA of 3.5 and above in the final year of studies.
- Must be between the ages of 20 and 30 years old.
- Excellent writing skills;
- Outstanding interpersonal communication skills;
- Confidence to express opinion and support it with facts;
- Sound computer skills;

PNG NRI Research Internship Training program is for a period of 12 months.

Applications for the 2021/2022 Research Internship Training Program are now open and will be received at the PNG NRI office until **4:06 PM Friday 16th of July 2021.**
